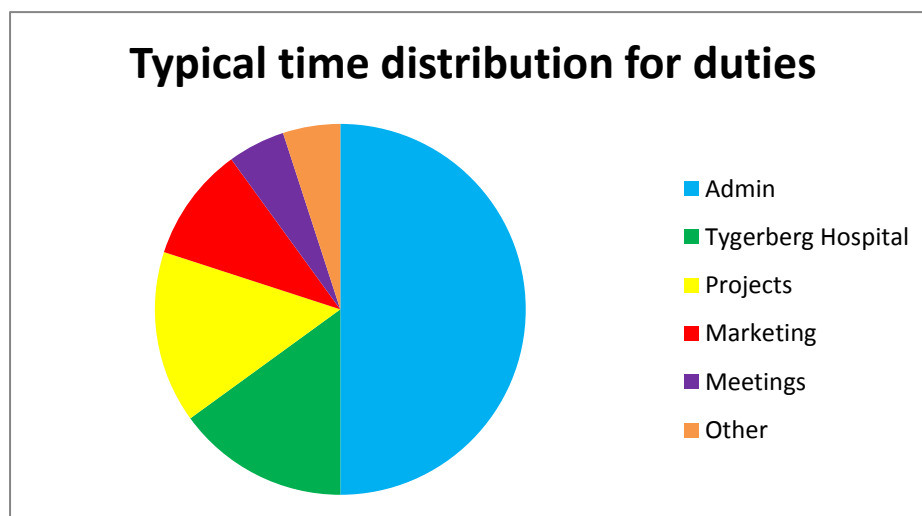
Work hours
